1.	What is AIAPGET?	AIAPGET is an entrance examination namely 'All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test' for admission to Postgraduate AYUSH Courses which will include the following: All India Open/Other State quota seats for admission to MD / MS / PG Diploma Courses in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha & Homeopathy system of medicine for all AYUSH Colleges, Institutions & Universities/ Deemed Universities across the country.
2.	What is the responsibility of NTA for AIAPGET?	The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting online application, conduct of entrance test, declaration of results and providing All India rank of candidates to All India Institute for Ayurveda for admission in MD / MS / PG Diploma Courses in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha & Homeopathy system of medicine.
3.	Will NTA reserve its discretion to fix the centre in a city which is given in the Information Bulletin?	As far as possible the candidate will be given the chosen city for test, however, NTA may need to use discretion due to administrative reasons.
4.	Can a centre be allotted by the NTA manually?	No
5.	Is there any Negative Marking in the AIAPGET?	There is Negative Marking in AIAPGET.
6.	Is there any helpline for AIAPGET Examination for the aspirants?	Yes. Details are available on website- <a href="http://www.nta.ac.in">www.nta.ac.in</a> , <a href="https://aiapget.nta.ac.in">https://aiapget.nta.ac.in</a> Helpline No.- 01140759000 (Operational 09:30 AM to 06:00 PM during working days)
7.	Is there any other place where queries can be raised?	Yes, Query Redressal System (QRS) is an online web-enabled system developed by NTA which aims to enable submission of queries/grievances by the Registered Candidate(s) of AIAPGET Examination for speedy response of the queries/grievances. This is a 24x7 system where a Unique Registration Number is generated for tracking the status of the queries/grievances. The Registered Candidate(s) are advised to use this online facility available in the "Candidate Login" for speedy response.
8.	Whether the examination will be offline or online?	It is a Computer Based Test.
9.	What is the medium of Question paper?	The medium of question paper are as under : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ayurveda- English and Hindi</li> <li>• Unani- English and Urdu</li> <li>• Siddha- English and Tamil</li> <li>• Homeopathy- English only</li> </ul>
10.	How will a candidate select a city of their choice for examination?	The candidate should select 4 cities of their choice in order of preference for examination of AIAPGET 2021 from the drop-down box where all cities where exam is going to be conducted would be reflected.
11.	What would be the Validity of AIAPGET 2021 result?	The validity of the result of AIAPGET 2021 shall be only for the current admission session i.e. 2021-22 for MD / MS / PG Diploma courses and cannot be carried forwarded for the next session of admission for MD / MS / PG Diploma AYUSH courses.

1.	What is the syllabus for AIAPGET?	The syllabus for the exam shall comprise of subjects/knowledge areas as per the Graduate Level Education Regulations of respective discipline issued by NCISM/NCH. Kindly refer to the NCISM/NCH for complete syllabus document.

4.	What should I do, if 'continuous timeout' or 'file not found' error occurs while filling online application form of AIAPGET?	Use updated version of browser with good internet connection while filling application form. In case of continuous time out one can clear cookies and history of the browser and fill in off-peak hours.	
5.	What are the enclosures that should be attached with the confirmation page to be sent to NTA?	Candidates are not required to send/submit any document(s) including Confirmation Page to NTA through Post/ Fax/ By Hand.	



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6.	Does NTA verify the documents and what is the role of NTA in counselling?	NTA does not verify the information provided by the candidates during online registration and hence candidature will be <b>purely provisional</b> subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as per NCISM/NCH/States/Universities/Institutions/ Deemed Universities concerned. <b>NTA has no role in counselling.</b>
7.	I have no access to a computer and no experience with Computer Based Examination. How can I prepare for the exam?	NTA has identified schools and colleges with internet and computer facilities. The same are designated as Test Practice Centers (TPCs) for facilitating free practice sessions for AIAPGET aspirants. An NTA Student App is also available on Google Play Store.
8.	What do the candidates need to bring to the exam center?	<p>The candidate is required to bring the following at the examination centre (The Candidates are also advised to read the Information Bulletin very carefully):-</p> <p>Admit Card along with passport size photograph affixed on it. One passport size photograph to be affixed on attendance sheet.</p> <p>Candidates are advised not to bring any other item in the examination centres. There will be no arrangement for safe keeping of any material at the centre. Neither NTA nor centre will be responsible for any loss, delay etc.</p>



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<b>9.</b>	Requirement for photograph?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Photograph should not be with cap or goggles. Photograph should cover 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background.</li> <li>2. Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly.</li> <li>3. <b>Polaroid and Computer generated photos are not acceptable.</b></li> <li>4. <b>Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected.</b></li> <li>5. <b>Candidates may please note that if it is found that photograph uploaded is fabricated i.e. de- shaped or seems to be hand-made or computer made, the form of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using unfair means and the candidate would be dealt with accordingly.</b></li> <li>6. Application without photograph shall be rejected. The photograph need not be attested. Candidates are advised to take 6 to 8 passport size coloured photographs with white background.</li> </ol>
<b>10.</b>	Will any candidate be able to leave early if he finishes the test before the allocated test time?	No, candidate will not be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before the test concludes.
<b>11.</b>	When is the AIAPGET-2021 going to be held?	Exam will be held on <b>18 September 2021</b> .
<b>12.</b>	When Candidates can download Admit Cards for AIAPGET-2021?	Will be intimated later on the AIAPGET Portal.
<b>13.</b>	If a candidate is unable to download the Admit Card, whom should he/she contact?	Admit cards will not be sent to candidates. Candidates have to download the Admit Card from the website <a href="http://aiapget.nta.ac.in">aiapget.nta.ac.in</a> only. In case of any difficulty, mail us on <a href="mailto:aiapget@nta.ac.in">aiapget@nta.ac.in</a> or can call on helpline numbers mentioned in Information Bulletin.
<b>14.</b>	Can a candidate change the examination centre after allotment of Admit Card?	Examination Centre cannot be changed.
<b>15.</b>	If mistakenly during filling up of the form, wrong particulars are filled in the online form, how will it be corrected?	When the correction window is opened by NTA the correction in particulars of Application Form can be made online and submitted. Once submission is done after correction no further correction will be allowed.
<b>16.</b>	Can anyone cancel the application submitted for AIAPGET?	Online Application form submitted successfully cannot be cancelled/withdraw

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

S.NO	QUERIES	ANSWERS
1.	What is the minimum eligibility criteria/qualification for appearing in AIAPGET 2021?	Candidates who are pursuing BAMS/ BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS/Graded BHMS degree or Provisional BAMS/ BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS Pass Certificate recognized as per the provisions of the IMCC 1970/HCC 1973 Act and possess permanent or provisional registration certificate of BAMS/ BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS/Graded BHMS degree qualification issued by the NCISM/NCH/State Board/Universities/Deemed Universities and have completed/are completing one year of internship by <b>31<sup>st</sup> October-2021</b> as per the NCISM/AYUSH notification, may apply for AIAPGET 2021
2.	What is the age limit/relaxation criteria for the candidates appearing in AIAPGET 2021?	No age limit for AIAPGET-2021.
3.	What is the reservation criteria for seats falling under the jurisdiction of States?	It is as per State Reservation Policy.
4.	Whether the Compulsory Rotating Internship has to be completed from one hospital only?	No. The twelve months Compulsory Rotating Internship can be from various hospitals, but the total time period of internship has to be of one year duration.



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### Section IV

### FEE/PAYMENT QUERIES

S.NO.	QUERIES	ANSWERS
1.	Whether the application fee excludes the Common Service charge?	Yes
2.	How can one remit fee for AIAPGET 2021?	Pay fee using ICICI/Canara/Paytm Payment Gateway through Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking/UPI/Paytm and keep proof of fee paid. In case the Confirmation Page is not generated after payment of fee then the transaction is cancelled, and amount will be refunded to the candidate's account. However, the candidate has to make another transaction, in case the Confirmation Page is not generated.
3.	If any candidate faces any problem in remittance of fee due to failed transaction, what can he/she do?	If the payment status of online transaction (by credit/debit card) is not communicated by payment gateway in real time then fee payment is not completed and the candidate will not be able to download the Confirmation page. In this case, the candidate is required to pay fee again through online mode and download the Confirmation page. The amount due to failed transaction of credit/debit card will be refunded back after reconciliation with the bank.
4.	If a candidate for any reason has not appeared in the examination, is there any provision for fee refund?	No. Once the online application form is submitted successfully by the candidate, it cannot be withdrawn and no refund will be made.

### CLARIFICATION REGARDING AADHAAR

1.	Is Aadhaar mandatory for AIAPGET?	The Aadhaar number is only one of the types of identification and is not mandatory. Candidates may also enter Passport number, Ration Card number, Bank Account number or any other valid Government identity number.
